## Actress featured in TV Guide

She joined the soap in June as the nutty nanny and possible love interest for Nikolas Cassadine (Tyler Christopher). She is "creepily devoted" to Spencer, the infant Cassadine heir, TV Guide notes. On Tuesday she binds and gags Helena at Wyndemere Castle.

"She's really lost it now," Tepe says.
